

# ECBOPAA Indoor/Outdoor Winter Postal Shoot 2017

## PROGRAM:

May	Portsmouth 1 (Compound score large 10)
June	Shortened Chicago
July	Portsmouth 2
August	Shortened Chicago
September	Portsmouth 1 (Compound score inner 10 only)

## DESCRIPTION OF SHOOT:

### *Portsmouth 1*

Compound/Recurve 60cm target face, Crossbow 40cm target face (either full face or multi)  
10 zone scoring

In May Compound score the large 10

In September Compound score the inner 10 only

60 arrows (10 x 6 arrow ends or 20 x 3 arrow ends)

### *Shortened Chicago*

Compound/Recurve/Crossbow 40cm target face (either full face or multi)

5 zone scoring (9, 7, 5, 3, 1)

60 arrows (10 x 6 arrow ends or 20 x 3 arrow ends)

### *Portsmouth 2*

Compound/Recurve 60cm target face, Crossbow 40cm target face (either full face or multi)

5 zone scoring (9, 7, 5, 3, 1)

60 arrows (10 x 6 arrow ends or 20 x 3 arrow ends)

## DISTANCES TO BE SHOT:

Seniors shoot @ 18 metres

Juniors shoot from their correct Indoor JAMA distances

U/20, U/17 and U/15 shoot @ 18 metres

U/13 shoot @ 14 metres

U/10 shoot @ 11 metres

**PLEASE NOTE:** There are two different age divisions for juniors for this shoot, U20 (Teens) and U13 (Pre Teens). Juniors are asked to shoot from their correct distance according to the JAMA rulings but to either enter the U20 or U13 divisions. If a junior is 12 or younger on the 1<sup>st</sup> May they are to enter the U13 division and if they are 13 or older on the 1<sup>st</sup> May they are to enter the U20 division. There is also a Masters division for all bow types and genders. If you are 50 years old or older on the 1<sup>st</sup> May then you are entitled to shoot in the masters division.

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
